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Common Interview Process

Online Application

This is your first chance to tell the company about YOU!

Online Tests

Aptitude tests and psychometric tests help employers find out more about you. Some check whether you have the right practical skills for a job. Others help them see if you'll fit in with their team.

Telephone / Video Interview

Similar to the regular interview – but quicker and done in the comfort of your own home. Recruiters will want to find out how your skills/experiences and interests match that of the job.

Assessment Centre

Recruiters use assessment centres to find out how candidates perform in various situations, in particular group situations, *and*, social breaks!

Job Offer!

Getting to this point isn't easy! Last year one company received around 5000 early career applications, and made 1000 job offers.... Use the Early Careers Support Programme for support throughout!

Top Tips from Previous Students

“Get your applications completed as soon as possible and keep a table/chart which you can update with deadlines and how much you’ve done”

“Don’t put all your eggs in one basket... Have a look at apprenticeships that can still combine your interest but perhaps with something you’d never thought of”

“Don't show you are very worried during recruitment stages, relax and be friendly with everyone (especially in assessment centres)”

“Make sure you do well-rounded research on the company”

“Practice, practice, practice”

“Before an interview ask yourself if you can really see yourself working there. If the answer is yes then you will be able to have a good reason why”

“If you’ve been offered an interview grasp it with both hands and practice some typical interview questions”

“It can feel daunting when trying to complete studies and apply for apprenticeships, as well as going to interviews but by keeping really organised the tasks become a lot more manageable”

“Start applications as early as possible, some take a really long time to complete”

“Always ask for feedback”
